





Spotlight on Watermen's Licences Many of our readers will know that we have records concerning crew and seamen. But do you have watermen in the family? What you may ask are watermen? Watermen were boatmen licenced to ferry passengers. With watermen working on New South Wales waterways these could be an untapped source for family and maritime history. State Records holds the following records: NRS 10824, Watermen's Licences, Apr 1911-Feb 1935,[X2332] NRS 9847, Watermen's Licences, Sep 1936-Sep 1953, [X2333]

NRS 10925, Port of Newcastle, Watermen's Licences, 1912-24, [X2334-35] (only a few, appears to be incomplete) NRS 9822, Maritime Services Board Special Bundles; Licenced watermen on Sydney Harbour, 1902-08,[7/7500.2]. These lists record the name, licence/permit number and plying from (situation) and on some lists the name of the boat. Also included is a list 'those addicted to drink and those with convictions recorded against them, 1907' Applications for watermen's licenses and licenses for lighters (vessels) subject to seaworthiness, 1921-23, [8/2036.15] This appears to contain a sample of applications together with the inspector's report. The sample includes Sydney, Central Coast and Newcastle
