4. Shipping Master's Office: Articles of Agreement of Crews, 1878, 1880-1922 (4/9100-9610)

The agreements are arranged by year and then by the first letter of the vessel's name. Each agreement provides brief details of the vessel and its crew. The information about crew members is arranged under the following headings: signature; town or country where born; ship in which he last served; date and place of joining this ship; in what capacity engaged; amount of wages; and particulars of discharge.

A shelf list of these records is available in the Archives Office.

5. Mercantile Marine Office: Registers of seamen engaged on board ships, 1864-1919

Registers of seamen's employment made on board the ship on which they were employed. Entries show registration number (in 5/503 only), date when engaged, date when registered, name of seaman, name of vessel, description, capacity, last ship, where bound, and master's or owner's name. 5/508 records in addition, age and birthplace of each seaman.

8. Mercantile Marine Office: Index of seamen engaged before the Shipping Master, 1917-20 (5/530)

9. Mercantile Marine Office: Registers of seamen discharged, 1859-1916

The first volume shows registration number, date, seaman's name, ship, description, seaman's signature, and witness's remarks (concerning character).

Other volumes record: date of entry; registration number; name of seaman; capacity; ships in which last served; description (of ship); name of master; date of release from last ship; nature of release (whether paid in full or forfeit); port of registry; place of birth; description or nature of voyage (colonial, intercolonial or foreign); report of conduct, character or qualifications; master's declination to comment on conduct, character or qualifications (reasons for); and name of witness.

The index shows, in alphabetical order, date of discharge and registration number against each seaman's name.

11. Mercantile Marine Office: Registers of discharge papers received from Masters of Vessels, 1864-1921

The registers note registration number, date of seaman's discharge, name of seaman, capacity, name of ship seaman last discharged from, date of receipt of discharges by the Shipping Master, date of delivery of discharges by the Shipping Master, signature of seaman on receiving his discharge, witness to signature, and remarks on conduct, character and qualifications. The last volume also shows date of engagement.

13. Mercantile Marine Office: Articles of agreements and Accounts of Crews, 1875, 1881-1922 (Kingswood 6/737-88a)

For foreign going ships, the Articles show name of ship, official number, port of registry, port number and date of register, gross and net registered tonnage, nominal horsepower of engines (if any), name and address of registered managing owner or manager, number of seamen for whom accommodation is certified, and the load line and draught of the vessel.

The Crew Agreement relates to the length of the voyage and notes conditions, date and place of the commencement of the voyage, signature of master, signatures of crew, their ages, nationalities, port of engagement and home address, name of ship last served in and year of discharge, date and place of signing the agreement, capacity in which engaged, number of certificate (if any), commission, date and hour at which each member of the crew is to be on board, amount of wages per week or calendar month, amount of wages advanced upon or at the time of engagement, amount of weekly or monthly allotment, and particulars of discharge including date, place and cause of death or release.

These are arranged chronologically by year of departure and then alphabetically by name of the ship.
