# Updates from Government Recordkeeping

#### Review of the State Records Act 1998

- Consultation with selected stakeholders familiar with the operation of the Act to identify issues for the review to consider
- Issues paper due out in May
- Review will consult broadly with stakeholders on the issues, including NSW public offices, archives users and the public

## Updates ...

#### Storage standard and guidance

- New Standard on the physical storage of State records issued to all public offices in February
- Revised guidance and Implementation Guide available on website

#### Revised Counter Disaster Strategies guidance

- Guidance has been revised to support new Storage standard and will be published in May
- Counter disaster plans are essential to protecting physical records
- Reminder to assess risks affecting records, update priority records lists, and review response and recovery plans

## Updates ...

#### Closure of Future Proof strategy and website

- Future Proof strategy commenced 2007
- Designed to improve digital recordkeeping across NSW
  Government and to implement a digital State archives facility
- Future Proof website will continue to be accessible for reference purposes, but no new content
- April 2019 Forum recordings will be available on the Government Recordkeeping website

## Updates ...

#### State Archives Management System (SAMS)

- New control system for the State Archives Collection
- Integration of new control system, digital asset management system, and a search and discovery layer for the public.
- Some changes when transferring records to SARA, e.g. introduction of barcodes which are required to be attached to boxes and volumes
- Commenced using SAMS at the beginning of April
- Further information available on our website soon on modifications to our transfer procedures which include information about the new system's requirements.
